Licensed Assisted Living	Non-Licensed Facilities
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Regulated by the State of Indiana• Annual survey conducted by the State Board of Health• Annual Life Safety Survey• Licensed Health Facility Administrator serves as the director of the residence• Must obtain continuing education credits	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Not</u> regulated
Medication <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Licensed Nurse administers medications• All medications are reviewed periodically by a licensed pharmacist	Medication <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Medication reminders
Nursing <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Licensed nurse on site or on call 24 hours a day• Care is give by a Certified Nursing Assistant or licensed nurses• Health status monitoring performed with notation of condition changes	Nursing <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Caregivers not required to be licensed or certified• Non-licensed state perform a wide range of health services
Dietitian Services <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certified Dietary Manager required• Registered Dietary Consultant	Dietitian Services <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Not</u> required
Activities Program <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Certified Director required	Activities Program <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Not</u> required
Training <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continued training required by Indiana State Board of Health	Training <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Training <u>not</u> mandated
