Car Show and Barbecue scheduled June 21 at Touchmark at Fairway Village

A complimentary barbecue will be served from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m. Lunch includes hamburgers, hotdogs, salad, baked beans, watermelon, ice cream sandwiches and water. Additional beverages from two beer gardens will be available for purchase.

There is no charge for the lunch or show, but donations will be accepted for Loaves and Fishes, “Meals on Wheels People.” Since the first year of the event, \$6,000 has been donated to this nonprofit that provides food for seniors.
