Touchmark at Coffee Creek was recognized by The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for its leading green-power purchase. Touchmark at Coffee Creek is the largest nonpublic green-power user in Edmond, Oklahoma. Since 2006, Touchmark has been purchasing alternative power from Edmond Electric and buys more than 2 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) of green power annually—enough green power to meet 100% of the its electricity use.

The purchase qualifies Touchmark for EPA’s Green Power Leadership Club, a distinction given to organizations that have significantly exceeded EPA’s minimum purchase requirements. Green Power Leadership Club members must purchase 10 times the partnership’s minimum requirement.
