

## ***This is the reason taking care of your pet's teeth is so important!***

*This is a resorptive lesion on a cat's tooth I found on a routine dental last week. (That is a dental probe sticking through the tooth!) The owner had no idea it was there. They are like cavities, only much worse and are found in 15% of modern cats but were not seen in over 600 cat skulls recovered from ancient Egyptian tombs. They are very painful and cats react to probing them even when anesthetized. The only treatment is extraction. This cat had one other tooth affected. Both were extracted and she is feeling much better now!*
